31.5j± wingspan, 37j± length, 26.5oz flying weight. The plane is made of great balsawood.

Totally produce like the real plane just reduce it. It will fly very well if it comes with 6 servos , R28C-1 1200kv Brushless Motor, 30A motor controllers and 8*6 APC Thin-Electric prop. The plane flies out easily and climbs strongly in several meters. Its flying is very graceful and could all actions . Its landing is very balance.

35.4"wingspan,22.4"long ,21.2-22.9oz flying weight.This is a fangled plane that make of balsa wood. It's pusher power which Isdifferent with ordinary planes.The pusher power is stronger than the opposite one , so it needn't big motor .What this plane could do are roll ,fall flying,whorl,dive and so on. very balance when its landing.
